4 True Aspects of Character

- A. Often in interviews, "how you handled your last failure." Failure is embarrassing, humiliating = it crushes pride
- B. Success usually inflates pride
 Advice: 20% of people love you, 20% hate you, believe the 60% in the middle
- C. Matthew 5:3-6

2. A willingness to be misunderstood

Matthew 10:24-25

John 9:13-34

- A. At some point, every leader will be misunderstood.
 At some point, people will say things about you that aren't true-judge motives & get it wrong.
- B. Character: Sometimes you can't tell the whole story.
 - Not because you are being secretive, but because revealing all the information would make others look bad or break a confidence.

So...you bear looking bad.

C. Bear being misunderstood for now, knowing usually the truth comes out. Proverbs 18:17

3. Private life matches public image

- A. "What's she really like?"
- B. In The President's Secret Service by Ronald Kessler
- C. "Being Real"
 - 1. Honest:
 - Don't pretend you have it all together
 - Don't pretend you're better than others
 - Don't pretend you know everything
 - 2. Pure: Solid, Consistent
 - \neq Perfect
 - = No deceit, no manipulation
 - 3. Holy: Set Apart Direction \neq Destination
- D. My life is my message
 - 1. You can fool some of the people some of the time, you can't fool all the people all of the time.
 - 2. Matthew 5:13-16 Acts 5:20
- E. Imitate you?
 - 1. 1 Corinthians 4:16 1 Corinthians 11:1
 - 2. Raising children "Do as I say, not as I do" doesn't work Because they "Imitate you"
- F. Warning/Danger
 - 1. Pharisees "Religious" (\neq Real)
 - Matthew 23:4-7, 14, 23-28
 - 2. Luke 18:9-14
