740BC Hezekiah is born 728-715 Co-regency with Ahaz Hezekiah's age: 12-25 715-687 Sole Regency at 25 years old His son, Manasseh is 698 born, Hezekiah is 42 687-686 Co-Regency with Manasseh Manasseh's sole 686 regency

Religious Reform 2 Chron 29-31

Hezekiah's first order of business was to reestablish God as the King of Judah, returning to a functioning THEOCRACY, in which the human king submits to Him.

Hezekiah's fortifications

- Warren's Shaft
- the Siloam Channel
- Hezekiah's Tunnel [or the Siloam Tunnel]
- Retook the cities his father forfeited
- Fortified the national economy & military
- Agriculture & trade expanded by warehouses & stockyards in strategic places
- National system of defense was inaugurated
